Sunday, April 7th is Divine Mercy Sunday

THE CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY AS A NOVENA BEGINS ON GOOD FRIDAY - MARCH 29, 2024

Sister Faustina wrote in her Diary: "The Lord told me to recite this chaplet for the nine days before the Feast of Mercy. It is to begin on Good Friday. Then he told me: By this novena (of chaplets), I will grant every possible grace to souls. (Diary of A Soul, Book II, #197)

FIRST DAY - Today bring to me all mankind, especially **ALL SINNERS** (pray the chaplet).

SECOND DAY - Today bring to me all the **SOULS OF PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS** and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy (pray the chaplet).

THIRD DAY - Today bring to me all the **DEVOUT AND FAITHFUL SOULS** and immerse them in the ocean of mercy (pray the chaplet).

FOURTH DAY - Today bring to me those who **DO NOT BELIEVE IN GOD** and those who do not yet know Me (pray the chaplet).

FIFTH DAY - Today bring to me the **SOULS WHO HAVE SEPARATED FROM MY CHURCH** and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy (pray the chaplet).

SIXTH DAY - Today bring to me the meek and humble souls and the souls of **LITTLE CHILDREN** and immerse them in My mercy (pray the chaplet).

SEVENTH DAY - Today bring to me the souls who especially **VENERATE AND GLORIFY** my mercy and immerse them in My mercy (pray the chaplet).

EIGHT DAY - Today bring to me the souls who are **DETAINED IN PURGATORY** and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy (pray the chaplet).

NINTH DAY - Today bring to me souls who have become **LUKE-WARM** and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy (pray the chaplet).

THE CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY

- ◆ Begin with the Sign of the Cross, 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.
- ◆ Then on the Our Father beads say the following: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- ◆ On the 10 Hail Mary beads say the following: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- ◆ Conclude with (three times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
